**AN EVENING WITH MABEL** – Local filmmaker to host Argentine cultural event, presents a gripping documentary, FINDING MABEL, which explores her personal journey through Argentina to find her namesake, one of Argentina's 30,000 'Disappeared'.

Tickets are \$20 and proceeds go towards post production & film festival submissions. Media inquiries are welcomed. Journalists with valid press credentials will be admitted free.

*Finding Mabel* takes the audience on a journey through both contemporary and historic Argentina as the filmmaker reconstructs the stirring true story of her namesake, Mabel.

"As the namesake of one of Argentina's 30,000 disappeared, this project is deeply personal for me. It is a quest to honor my namesake, Mabel, and to explore my own identity and that of my Argentine heritage," says the filmmaker. "I am so excited to bring Mabel's legacy to light and to honor her by sharing this long time passion project with my Los Angeles community."

Eileen Mabel was born and raised in California after her parents fled Argentina to the US during Argentina's military dictatorship in the 1970's.
